

Nominated for the CONSTANTINUS Award

The project "Exploitation and Dissemination Management in a European cooperative research project" was nominated in 2016 to the prestigious Austrian CONSTANTINUS Consulting and IT Award in the category of International Projects. The selection was done in a two-stages process by a jury of 80 members, who chose 6 projects in each category among a total of 152 candidates. Following their nomination, Xedera's team and Marianne Hörlesberger from AIT had the honour of presenting the project in the "Walk of Success" (*Strasse der Sieger*) at the Constantinus Day in Design Center Linz.

It has become the leading national award for knowledge-based services in Austria and has been recognized by the Austrian Federal Government as the sole qualifying process for the Federal State Award 'Consulting - Management Consultancy and Information Technology'.
